




Fig 1. The entrance to the Harriman Building, Rancho Los Amigos Medical Center North campus is shown.



# JBJS, October 1993, obituary




VERNON L. NICKEL, M.D 1918-1993

Vernon L. Nickel "was an extraordinary orthopaedic surgeon. He developed the field of orthopaedic rehabilitation and established it as an integral part of orthopaedic residency training"







Dr. Jacquelin Perry, a legendary physician and researcher, is considered the Grande Dame of Orthopaedics.

Dr. Perry was the world's most accomplished physician in Rehabilitation Medicine and the study of human gait analysis. She began her long association with Rancho Los Amigos National Rehabilitation Center in 1955 and continued to be a major contributor to the renowned hospital's work during the remainder of her life, most recently serving as Emeritus Chief of Rancho's Polio and Gait Clinic and Pathokinesiology Program.
